WHERE WE ARE



In 365 days, **\$31,999** was given to change lives. We spent \$3,449 on expenses (insurance, website, donation platform, fees). We have 14 faithful monthly donors that provides \$930 to care for the children!!

In **2019**, Children remained in school in Mafubira and Buluuta. Patients were still being treated at the clinic. The construction of the children's home, kitchen, latrine, cow shelter, and playground were completed. Solar panels, beds, boots, blankets were also purchased.

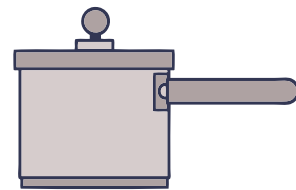

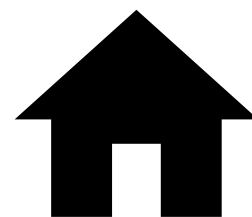
